- A "display" of work by the artist (rather like a mini-one artist show)----
- An "installation" specifically designed for the window (can use alternative materials to express an idea or theme)----

DESIRED OUTCOMES:

- Utilize empty spaces in ways that provide exhibition opportunities for regional artists.
- Enliven Yakima's downtown core through temporary art displays in empty window spaces, thus contributing to a vibrant downtown Yakima
- Highlight the talent of Central Washington artists through the window displays, press releases
 and other media promotion. Images of each artist's work will appear on Windows Alive website
 plus may be used by the City of Yakima, the Arts Commission and Yakima Valley Tourism for
 the promotion of the show and program.

ELIGIBILITY: Artists residing in Yakima, Yakima County and Central Washington

ARTWORK(s):

Visual Arts: All types of media are welcome: Paintings, drawings, fiber art, crafts, ceramics, photography, alternative materials, sculpture, etc.

WHAT IS REQUIRED:

- 1. APPLICATION FORM
- 2. ARTIST'S STATEMENT Discuss the subject / theme of the work and the materials used to create the work(s), 500 words or less. Must be in Word document on thumb drive/CD OR emailed to yakimawindows@gmail.com.
- 3. RESUME
- 4. TEN SAMPLE IMAGES OF YOUR CURRENT WORK and / or WORK THAT CAN BE USED IN A WINDOW "DISPLAY" OR "INSTALLATION" FORMAT on CD or thumb drive (can include at least 2 details of each image) Also include an annotated list of the artworks listing: title, size, media for each work. Future window displays could have a theme and designed as an art installation itself; or the display could be presented as an "exhibition" of an artist's work.
- A SELF ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE for the return of your CD/ or thumb drive and materials. Otherwise, the Yakima Arts Commission is not responsible for the materials.

ARTWORK ENTRIES WILL BE JURIED FROM CDs or thumb drives only.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS: BY 5:00 PM February 29, 2020.

TIME FRAME FOR ARTIST DISPLAYS or INSTALLATIONS WILL VARY. Our goal is to have the show ready for the First Friday event, April 3, 2020

JURY PROCESS: Artists will be chosen by members of the Yakima Arts Commission.

EXHIBIT AND INSTALLATION DETAILS: A contract and installation details will be sent to each artist once notified. Actual artwork for the windows will be reviewed after the artist(s) have been selected.

No longer than 500 words. We reserve the right to edit.

CD OR THUMB DRIVE SUBMISSION GUIDELINES for "Windows Alive"

- Artwork will be juried from digital photo files submitted on your CD or thumb drive.
- No photographic slides or prints will be accepted.
- Digital images must be cropped to the artwork itself in the case of 2-D work.
- The digital image must be saved in a JPEG (jpg) format.
- Each file size must be smaller than 1 Megabyte.
- Label your CD with a permanent marker with your name and phone number. If using a thumb drive, include a Word document on the drive with your name and contact information.
- Your CD/thumb drive will not be returned unless accompanied by a self-addressed envelope stamped with sufficient postage.
- TEST YOUR CD OR THUMB DRIVE before submitting. Must be readable on a WINDOWS program.
- For each artwork include one overall image and up to 2 detailed images for two dimensional work. For three dimensional work include up to 4 details.
- Files must be named: "A, B, C, or 1, 2, 3 -title of work, medium.jpg. For example: "B -Morning Walk – watercolor jpg." Letters or numbers should match the annotated list.
- Detail images should be labeled: "A detail 1, A –detail 2, etc.
- Actual size of accepted artwork :
 - 2- dimensional work cannot exceed 72" in any direction. 3 Dimensional work cannot exceed 8 square feet of floor space or weigh over 100 pounds.

ARTWORK WILL BE JURIED FROM CDs OR THUMB DRIVES ONLY. DO NOT SUBMIT ORIGINAL ART.
